

Matthew 13: Parables on the Gathering

Reference	Parable	Summarize the meaning of the parable
vv. 3–9, 18–23 1-Red Team	The Sower—the seeds grow differently depending on the ground they fall on.	
vv. 24–30 2-Green Team	The Wheat and Tares— an enemy plants tares in a wheat field. The householder tells his servants to let the wheat and tares grow together until the harvest.	
vv. 31–32 3-Blue Team	The Mustard Seed— the smallest seed grows into the largest of herbs.	
v. 33 3-Blue Team	The Leaven—a small amount of yeast in three measures of flour grows until it leavens all the dough.	
v. 44 3-Blue Team	Hidden Treasure—a man sells all he has to buy a field with a hidden treasure.	
vv. 45–46 4-Brown Team	Pearl of Great Price— a merchant sells all he has to buy the most valuable pearl.	
vv. 47–50 4-Brown Team	The Fish Net—fishers catch all kinds of fish in their net, and they separate them later.	
v. 52 4-Brown Team	New and Old Treasures—a righteous scribe brings out both old and new treasures.
